



REGULATIONS ON BOARD THE ARGOS

NON-STOP GLENAN CRUISES

Onboard Access Conditions – Safety Information

As part of the operation of the Argos launch for non-stop Glénan cruises, certain technical constraints impose certain onboard access conditions, in accordance with maritime safety requirements.

Accessibility

Unfortunately, the Argos launch is not accessible to people who cannot board and move around independently. This is due to:

- The lack of suitable gangways
- The need to navigate obstacles and sea-related movements
- Navigation conditions that can be physically demanding

Boarding Requirements

Access on board is reserved for persons:

- In good general physical condition
- Able to board, disembark, and move around on board independently, without assistance
- Not suffering from medical conditions that could be aggravated by navigation (e.g., heart or respiratory problems, dizziness, back pain, etc.)

Safety Measures

To ensure the safety of all passengers:

- No specific arrangements are available on board to compensate for these constraints
- Staff reserves the right to refuse boarding to any person whose health or mobility condition prevents safe boarding, for themselves or other passengers

In the event of denied boarding based on these criteria, no refund will be granted. This measure is intended to avoid any risk to the persons concerned.
